

ORDINANCE NO. 1-C

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Directors of the ROCKLIN-LOOMIS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT:

SECTION 1

Section 28 of Ordinance 1-A of Rocklin-Loomis Municipal Utility District is hereby amended to read as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, in cases where the Board of Directors or General Manager determines that a health hazard exists, or that there is a reasonable likelihood that a health hazard will exist, the Board or Manager may proceed under the provisions of Section 5463 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California, in which cases the provisions of that section shall take precedence over the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 2

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication pursuant to the provision of Section 11910 of the Public Utilities Code.
