ORDINANCE NO. 1-H

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 73 OF
ORDINANCE NO. 1-G RELATING TO REFUNDS
FOR SENIOR CITIZENS

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Rocklin-Loomis Municipal Utility District has been advised that funds necessary for the construction of the Regional Sewage Treatment Plant for Rocklin-Loomis Municipal Utility District and the City of Roseville will be withheld by the State of California unless the Refund Program for Senior Citizens as provided for in Section 73 of District Ordinance 1-G is repealed;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF ROCKLIN-LOOMIS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT:

SECTION 1

Section 73 of Ordinance 1-G of Rocklin-Loomis Municipal Utility District is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its final passage.

SECTION 3

This Ordinance shall be published once a week for two

successive weeks in the Loomis News, a newspaper of general circulation published within the District, pursuant to the provisions of Section 11534 and 11910 of the Public Utilities Code.

This Ordinance was introduced at a Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of Rocklin-Loomis Municipal Utility District on the 7th day of October, 1976, and was passed at a regular meeting of said Board on the 4th day of November, 1976, by the following vote:
